

RENAL COLIC

Professional: Nurse working at the Access Clinic of the CIUSSS de l'Ouest-de-l'île-de-Montréal

Targeted user: Patient referred by MD/NP who is experiencing renal colic

Indication: Answers all general admission criteria for the Access Clinic

Specific inclusion criteria:

- Present signs of renal colic

Prescription: The referring MD/NP is responsible to prescribe analgesia, antibiotics and tamsulosin.

Specific exclusion criteria:

- Signs or urosepsis: shivers, fever, nausea, vomiting, tachycardia
- Intense pain for > 12h, not alleviated by analgesics
- Patient taking immunosuppressants
- Kidney disease or single kidney

CLINICAL ALERT

If unable to meet the delay for the consultation, the patient must be reassessed by the Access Clinic professional.

CLINICAL ALERT

If patient condition worsens at any time:
Send patient to ER.
