Information for medical specialists working in clinic and institutional settings



The Centre de répartition des demandes de services (CRDS) was created to give patients improved access to specialized services while assisting family physicians with specialized service referrals.

As a medical specialist, you will now see:

- Patients within the time frame established for their clinical condition (A-B-C-D-E);
- The consultation request (including a summary assessment of the patient) and any prerequisite examination results prior to the patient's appointment.

Information for family physicians



The Centre de répartition des demandes de services (CRDS) was created to give patients improved access to specialized services while providing family physicians with support in referring patients for specialized services.

As a family physician, you will have:

- Access to standardized consultation request forms developed by committees of medical specialists and family physicians;
- A single point of contact for sending all requests for an initial consultation with a medical specialist;
- An option on the form to request a specific specialist, clinic or institution;
- The ability to track your patient's record.

Steps for filling out a consultation request form

Via an Electronic Medical Record (EMR)

- 1. Fill out the consultation request form in your EMR
- 2. Print the duly completed consultation request form
- 3. Fax your request to the CRDS at 514 732-5121

Paper version
